

TO SERVE AS A VOLUNTEER OF ARSENAL CREDIT UNION, YOU MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Be a primary member of Arsenal Credit Union for more than one year. "Primary" means that you are listed first on the account (i.e., you are the main owner of the account).
- Have at least one other product relationship besides a savings account (checking, money market, CD, IRA, loan, online bill pay or direct deposit).
- Be a member in good standing of Arsenal Credit Union.
- Qualify for bonding with the credit union's fidelity bond carrier.
- Not be involved in a lawsuit against Arsenal Credit Union.
- Never had a judgment issued against you in a civil action based upon grounds of fraud, deceit or misrepresentation.
- Never caused this credit union to suffer a financial loss.
- Never been removed from office by a regulatory agency while acting as an officer, employee, consultant, or representative of any financial institution.
- Have no criminal record, no felony convictions or pending felony charges.
- Be free of any real or perceived conflict of interest that might reasonably be expected to prevent you from acting in the best interests of the credit union.
- Complete all forms, including an application, and submit it to the credit union by November 16 of the year preceding the election.
